Are you experiencing challenges parenting your teen or pre-teen? You are not alone!

Amal is offering a 10-week Connect© Parent Group for parents and caregivers of children ages 8-18. Connect© is an attachment-based program with the goal of strengthening the parent-child relationship. When parents better understand their child's attachment needs, they can respond to challenging behaviours in ways that support healthy development and strengthen the relationship.

Where: In-Person or Online

When: Parents meet with 2 group facilitators weekly for 1.5 hours. Registration for the next group ends on September 6th, 2024.

What to expect: Each session teaches an attachment perspective on parent-child relationships and adolescent development.

What happens during group: Parents watch role-plays, do exercises, and discuss ways of responding to challenging behaviours and problems.
